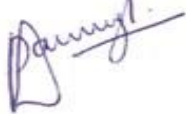

- (I) Program at NOCCI Balasore - NOCCI (North Orissa Chamber of Commerce & Industry) organized a seminar on the theme " From Ideas to Impact: Protecting Intellectual Property for Competitive Startups" during the Productivity Week Celebration 2025 In association with Odisha State Productivity Council, Bhubaneswar on 17th February 2025 at IFC, NOCCI, Ganeswarpur, Balasore. 04. RESOURCE UTILIZAION:

(I) Utilization of Cuttack Office:

The OPC office at Cuttack has been given on rent to Odisha Air Products Limited since 2013. Now the Rent has been enhanced in higher side to meet our rent which is being given for the OSPC office at Bhubaneswar.

- (II) **Membership:** Our membership base is being expanded with approaches to corporate houses, Institutions, Consulting Houses as well as knowledgeable personalities with the intention to have balanced funding position for future sustained progress.

To meet the basic expenditure for our infrastructure and secretariat to cover expenditure for the activities, our revenue is being increased considerably from the seminars. So an all out drive is to be made for expanding the membership.

05. Adoption of Annual Account

The Annual A/c has been audited with detailed schedules of Assets & Liability after adoption by the Governing Body in their meetings. The overall position in the Balance Sheet will show the cash balance, Fixed Deposits as well as schedule of the assets & liabilities. The Council is now financially sound and has potentiality of growth. We still however have financial crunch to meet the Revenue A/c expenditure.

06. BUDGETS / PLANNING

This process of having budget this year, advance budgeting estimates for the programmes will be further systemized & followed up by the Key Officers & Core Committee. While the Budget is projected on the basis of what we foresee, it will be augmented and expanded to cover all additional programmes / activities etc., in the different phases.

Zones will be advised to have their organization with proper documents & records for better effectiveness, credibility and transparency. The Zones needs follow up assistance from us in organizing themselves in their own areas.

07. FUTURE PROJECTION:

Our Council has been taking steps during the last several years to improve productivity at all levels. All members of OSPC are requested to use their good offices for development of OSPC movement, so that we can start the process with a development fund as quickly as possible. Depending on funds availability, the Productivity Center can be completed in phases. Effort will have to be made to make strategic planning for a sustained Growth of OSPC with the vision to have a “Center of Excellence in Productivity” and a continued corporate support to meet its regular annual expenditure.

We need a core group of active members and sponsorship on a consistent basis for large corporate Houses to effectively progress the secretariat work / development and contacts with Govt. Departments.

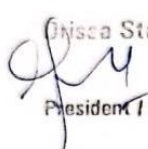
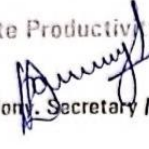
